



Interim Worship Leader Job Description

Scope of Ministry: To lead the congregation in vibrant, multi-generational worship that honors the Lord, encourages the members, and presents the Gospel of salvation to the lost.

Specific Skills Required:

- An authentic, growing relationship with the Lord as personal Savior.
- A personal commitment to authentic, enthusiastic worship.
- An understanding of songs that are singable, theologically sound, and meaningful for different generations of the church and the ability to plan a blended worship service.
- The ability to discern from the Lord a theme for a set of worship songs, and to plan songs that communicate the theme.
- The ability to lead from an instrument is preferred, but not required.

Specific Tasks:

- Plan, in consultation with the Pastor, an approach to each week's Worship Service.
- Select, in consultation with the Pastor, a set of songs that are singable and meaningful for all generations for the worship service.
- Load the worship order into Planning Center and communicate the selected songs with the church secretary for the bulletin and the Technology Team to load into ProPresenter.
- Rehearse at a time of mutual convenience with the worship team the songs planned for each week's worship.
- Lead the congregation in worship each Sunday morning.

Time Commitment:

- Consultation time with the Pastor each week for the worship plan: 1-2 hours
- Planning the worship service and selecting songs: 1-2 hours.
- Rehearsal with the worship team at a time that is mutually convenient: 1-2 hours.
- Leading the congregation in worship on Sunday Morning:
 - Arriving early for sound check and run-through.
 - Leading the congregation in worship.
 - Total: 3-5 hours.
- Total: 6-9 hours per week.

Salary: Commensurate with Experience.

Interim Leader MAY be considered for permanent part-time role if interested.
